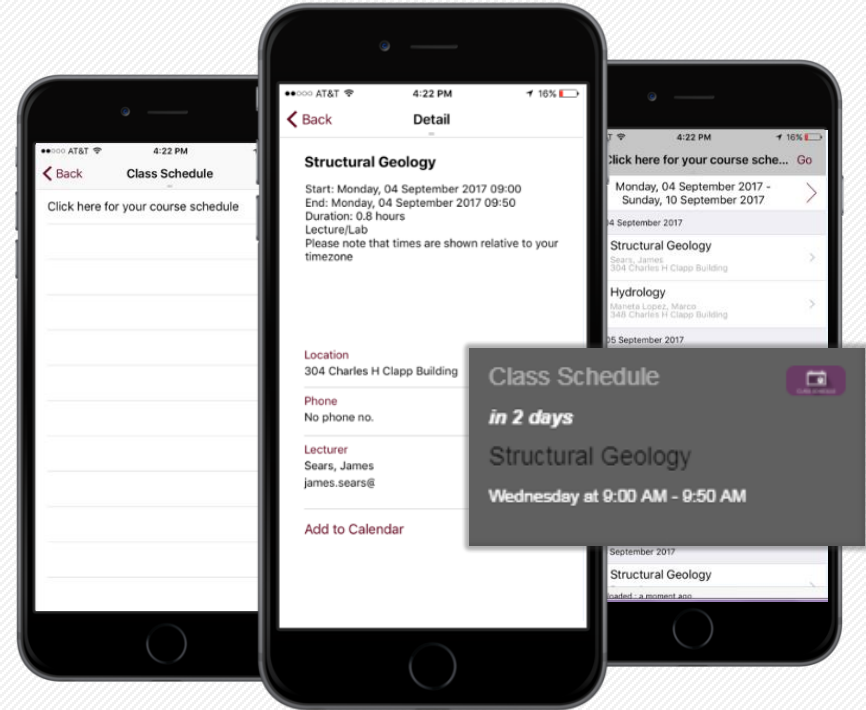
# Example Integration – Instructure Canvas

The LMS integration with Canvas has two different options available. Institutions can choose to integrate with a live tile that displays up to date information on the campusM home screen, or a static tile that will link the user directly to Canvas.



# Example Integration – CelCat Timetable

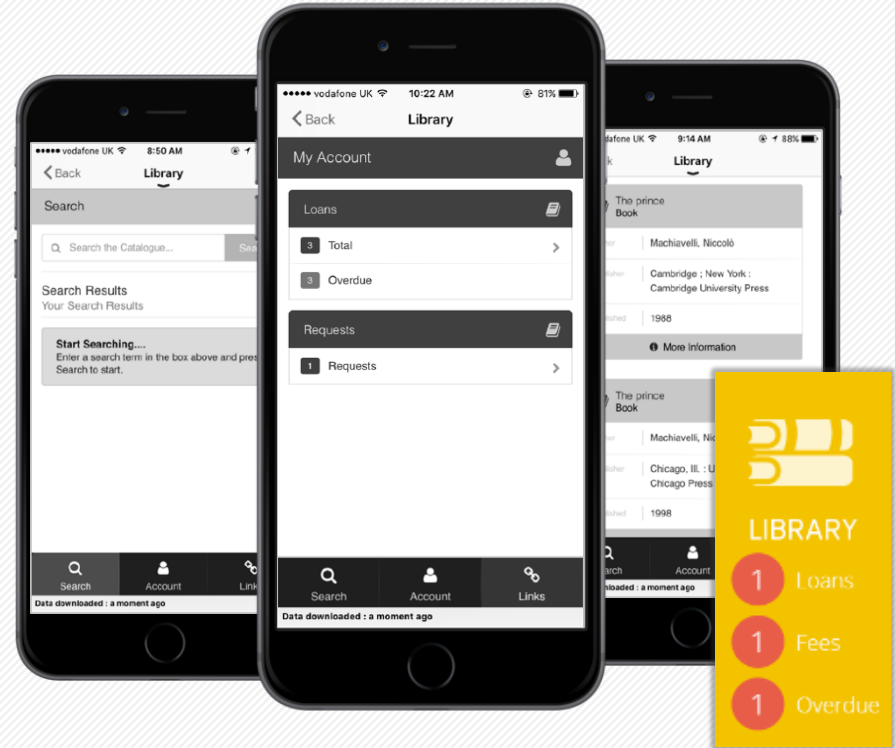
The class schedule integration allows students to view their class schedule by month (on web), weekly (on app), allows student to view details for a specific class.



# Example Integration – Ex Libris Alma-Primo

The library integration with Alma and Primo provide users the following functionality:

- Search for library resources and view a records metadata details
- View account information, including loans, requests and fines
- Link out to university-defined webpages
