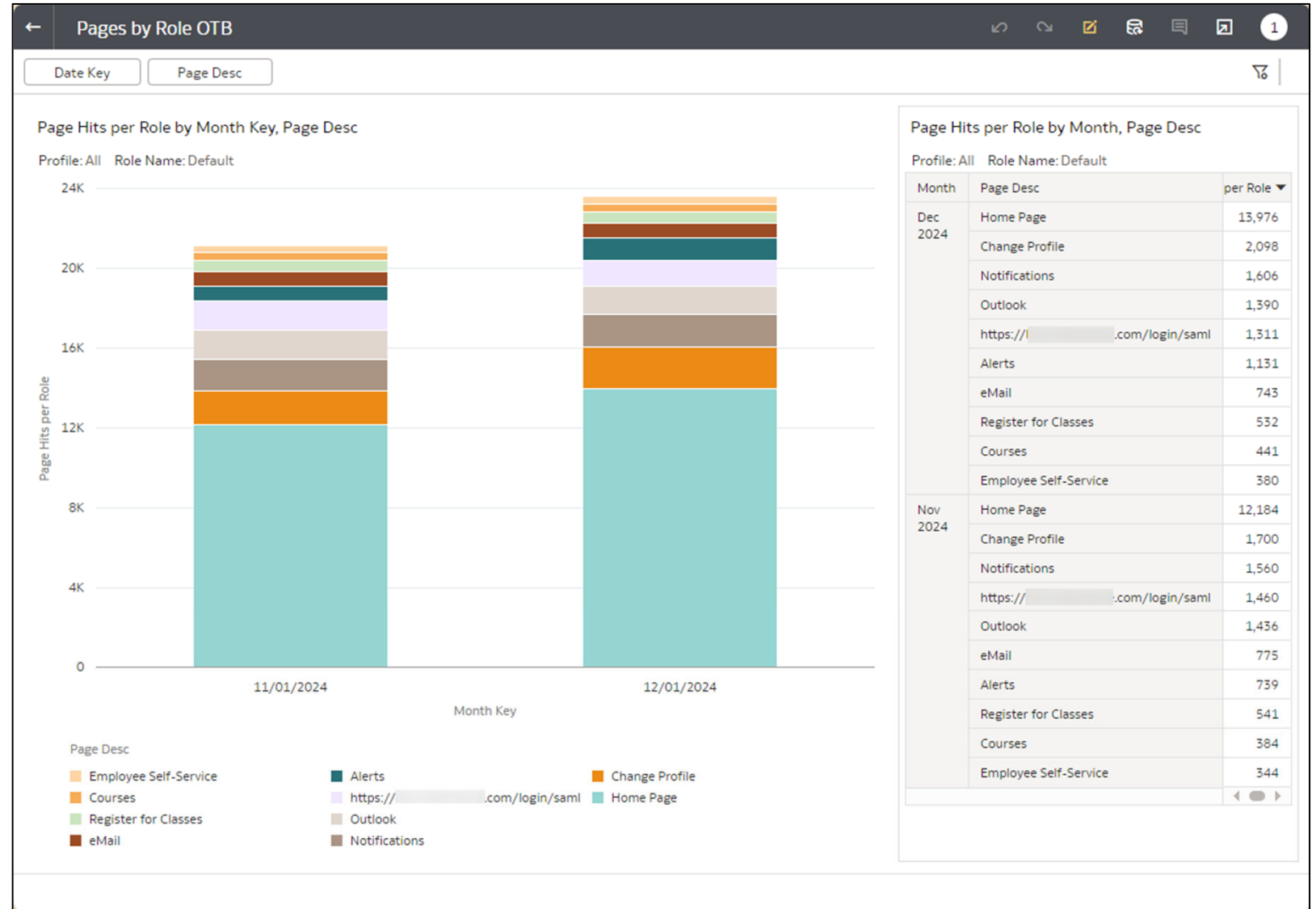

February 2025 - Analytics by Roles

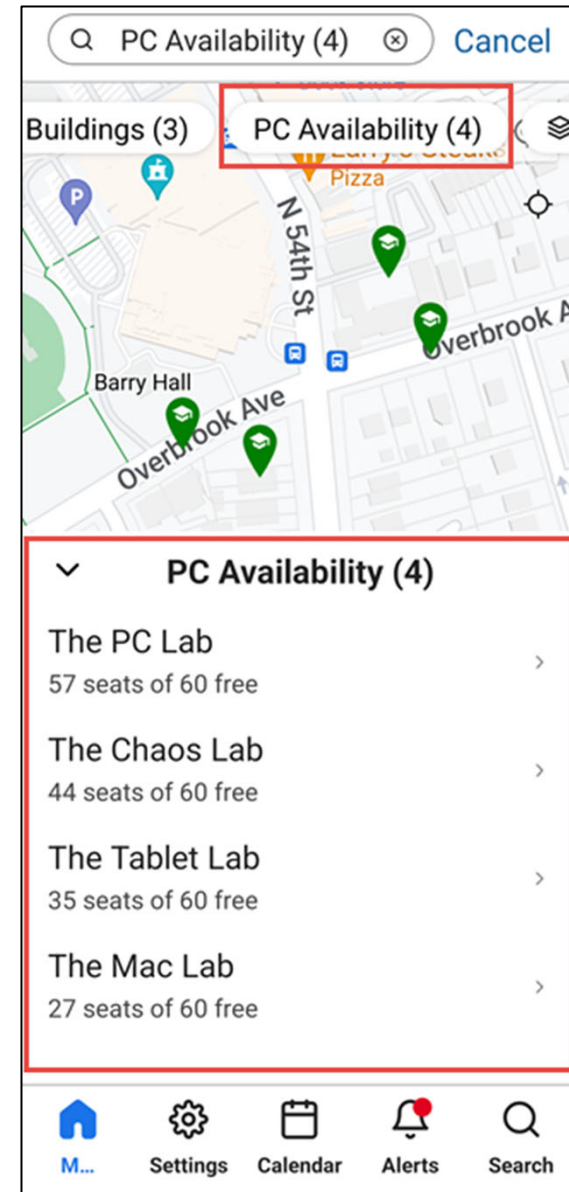
- These new subject areas enable you to break down data about tile clicks and page hits by user roles.
- This can indicate which tiles are most useful to users of different types.



Community-Driven Development 

February 2025 - PC Availability in Maps

- This feature can be used by institutions that provide PCs for students to use, for example, in libraries or laboratory environments.
- If your institution offers this type of service to students, and your system keeps track of which PCs are in use at any given time and which are available for students to use, you can provide this information in campusM maps.



March 2025 - Enhanced Role Notifications

- A new option has been added to the Send Advanced-role Notification page: Under Select your operator, the Only option has been added. Select this option if you only want to send the notification to users with the role selected under First Role.

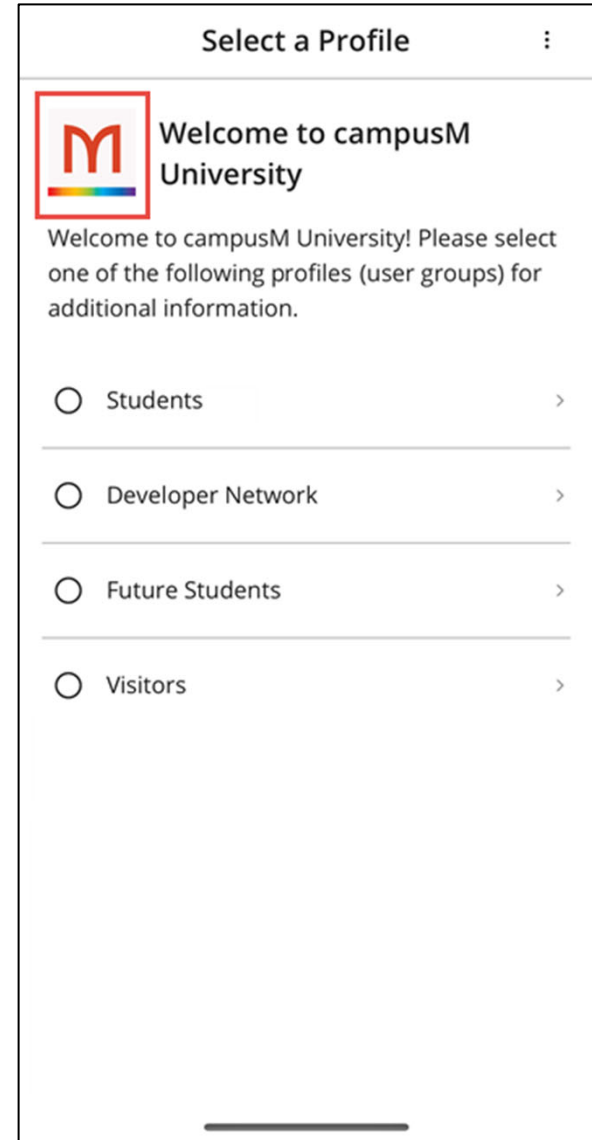

March 2025 - App Logo on Profile Selection

- React Native now supports the display of the institution's logo on the Select a Profile page.



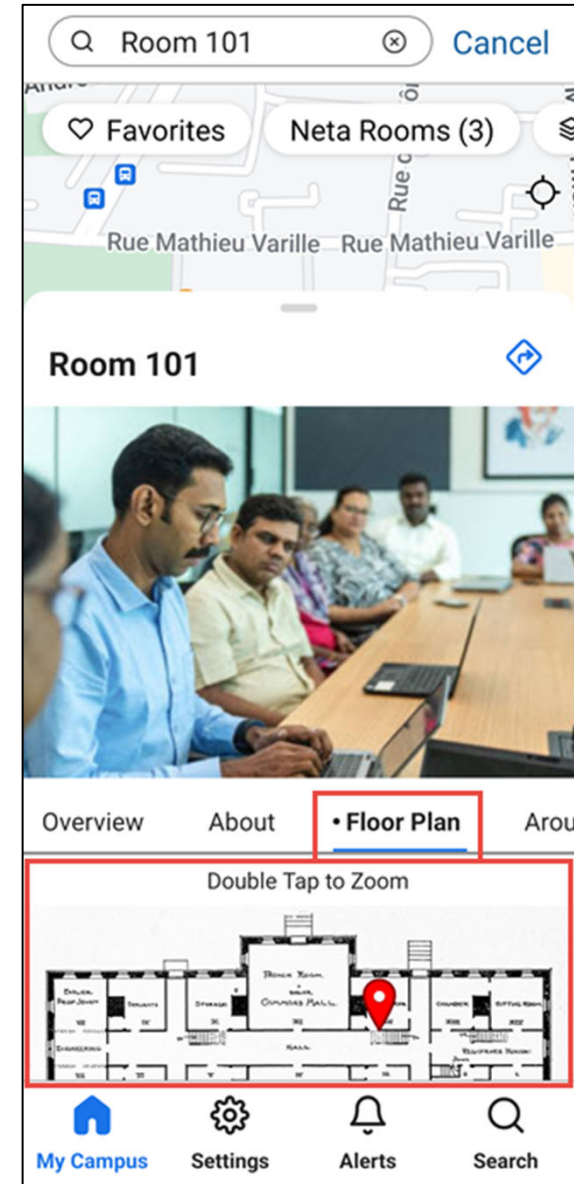
March 2025 - Newsfeed Product Integration

- This feature allows you to add one or more feeds (RSS or API) to a Newsfeed page.
- The main page of the Newsfeed UI displays the headlines of the items and an image. Users can select these items to view their full content.
- Feeds can be filtered by the end-user to limit the display to selected feeds, view items from preceding days, to save favorites, and to search for items whose titles and authors' names contain a specified string of text.
- Feeds are updated automatically every five minutes, so they are always kept up to date.



March 2025 - Floor Plans in Maps

- You can now create a map from an image file, and positions linked to that will see the image in the app when they select the position.
- This can be useful, for example, for providing floor plans of the interiors of buildings, or a custom campus map. The image is displayed in the bottom drawer, in the new Floor Plan tab, and the position it is linked to is marked on the image.



April 2025 - Web Calendar, now with Events!

- In accordance with the mobile React Native app, events from both Timetable and Events Product Integrations now appear on the web calendar.

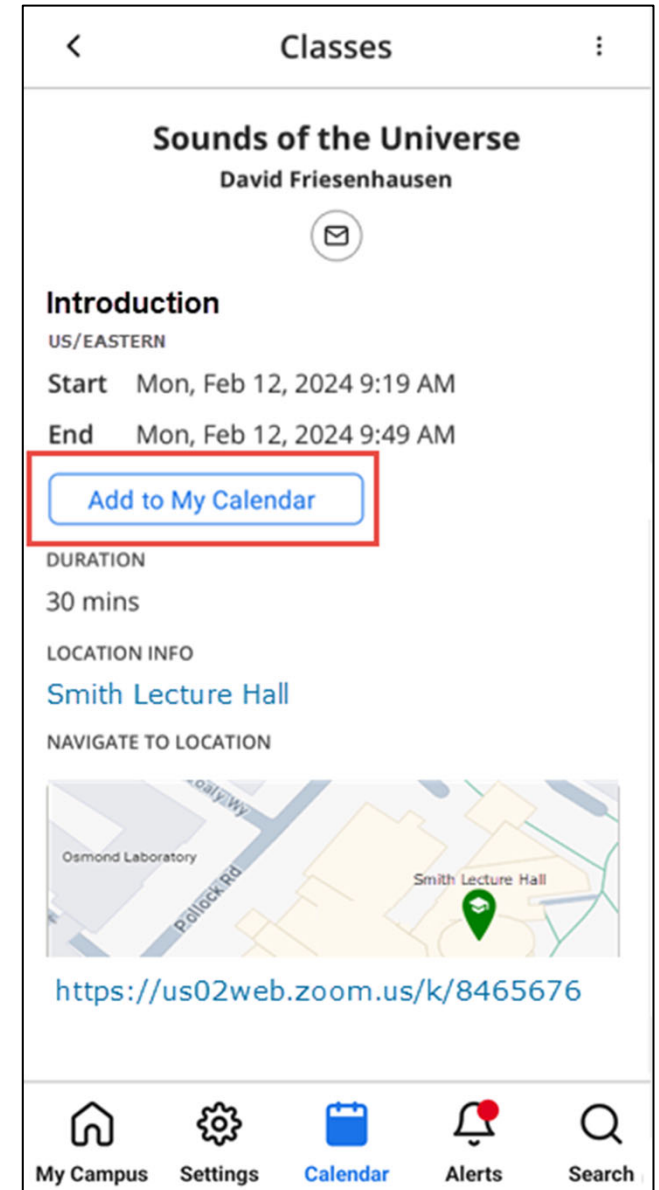

- End-users can now add any event in their mobile calendar to their default calendar app on their device.

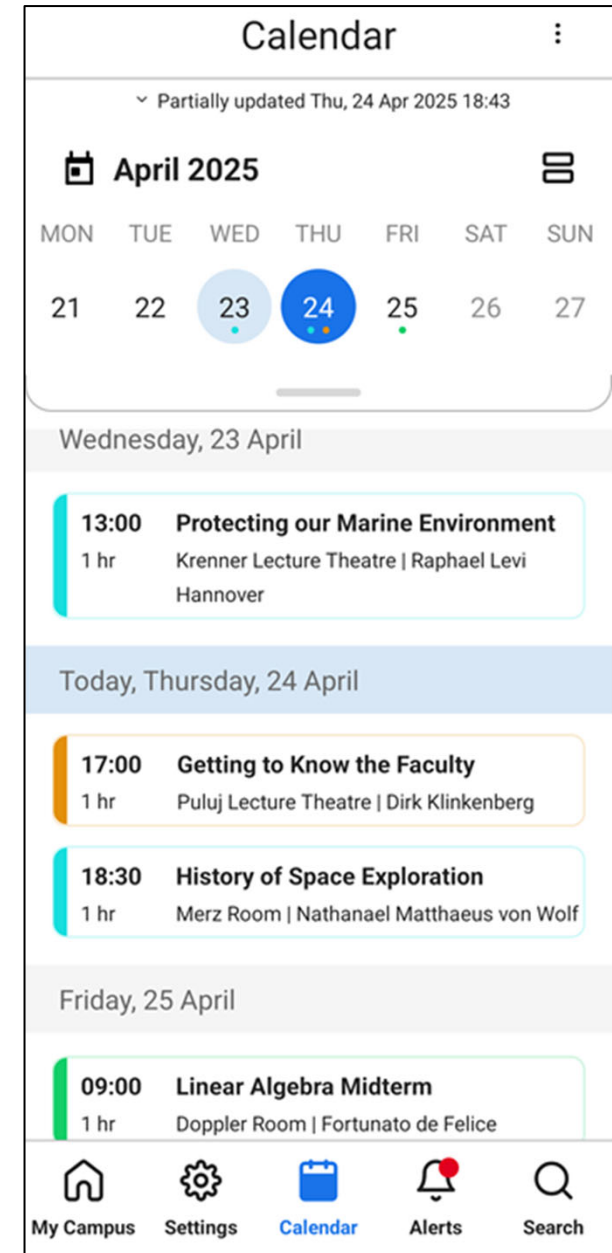

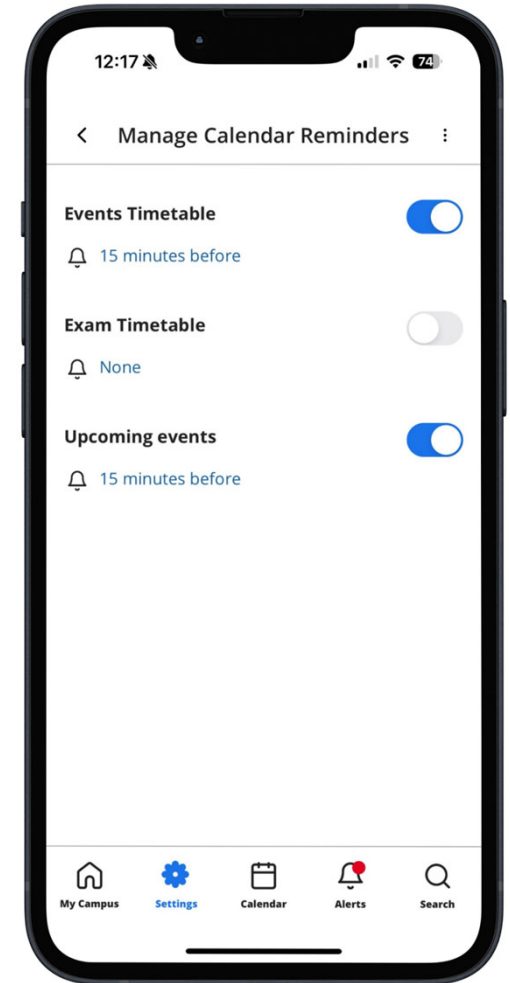
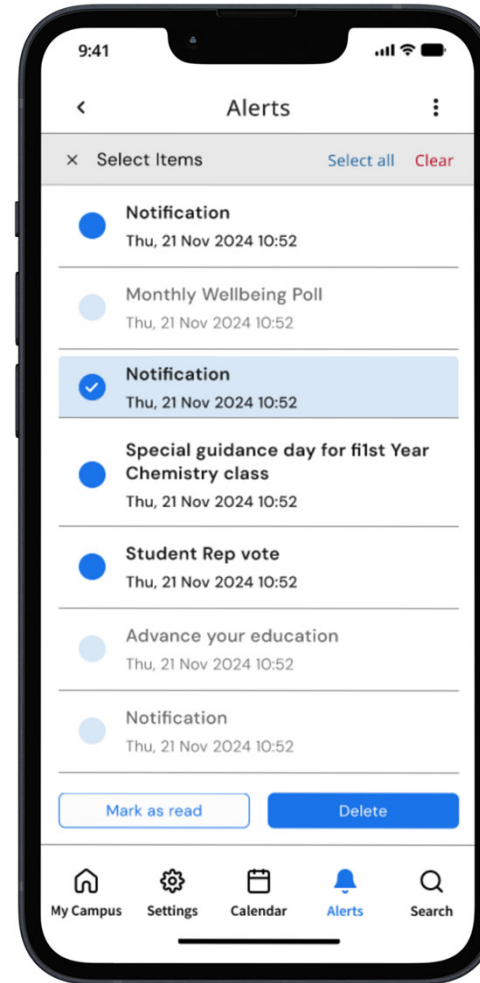

Ideas Exchange Enhancements

- **Multiday Calendar Scroll** - Done for June 2025
 - Improve calendar usability and navigability by enabling multiday vertical scroll.
- **Add to Calendar** - Done for May 2025
 - Add a specific activity from the activity's details page to the personal device calendar
- **Multiday event support** - scheduled for Q4
 - Multiday activities support in for Calendar: Outlook, RESTful API, and activities from Events Product Integration
- **Google Analytics Integration** - phase 1 scheduled for Q4
 - Ability to push Insight Analytics transactions to an institutions designated GA Environment
- **App Deep Linking** - phase 1 scheduled for Q4
 - Ability to link into key areas in the campusM App (Native and Web) from an external URL

Notification Enhancements

- Multiple Select functionality for bulk alert deletion
 - Mobile - July
 - Web - Q3
- Default calendar alert behavior per calendar feed - July



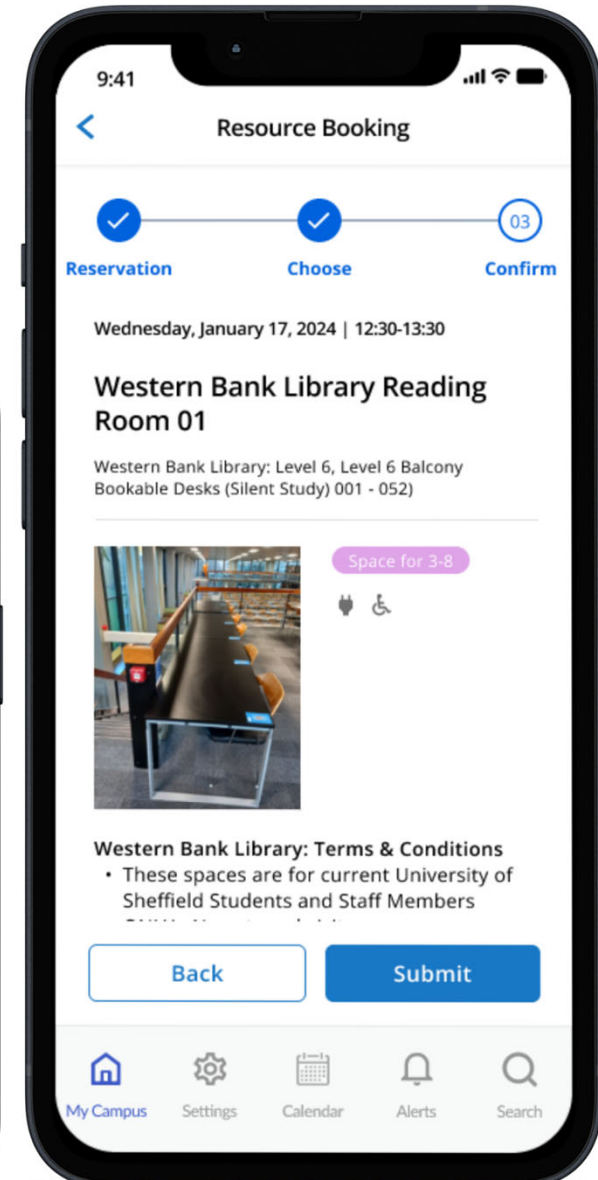
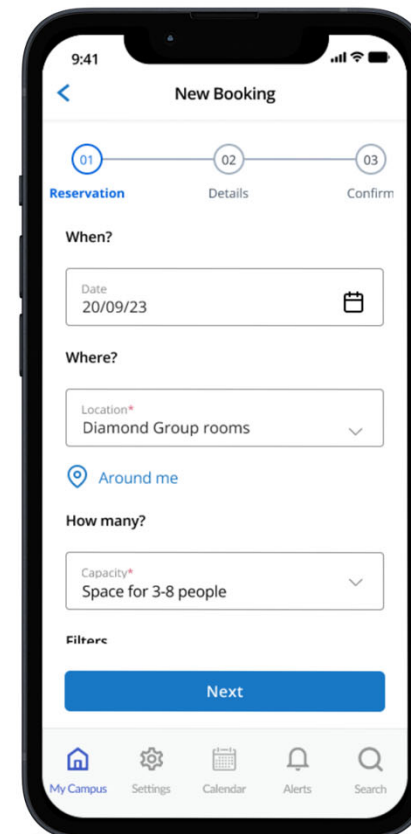
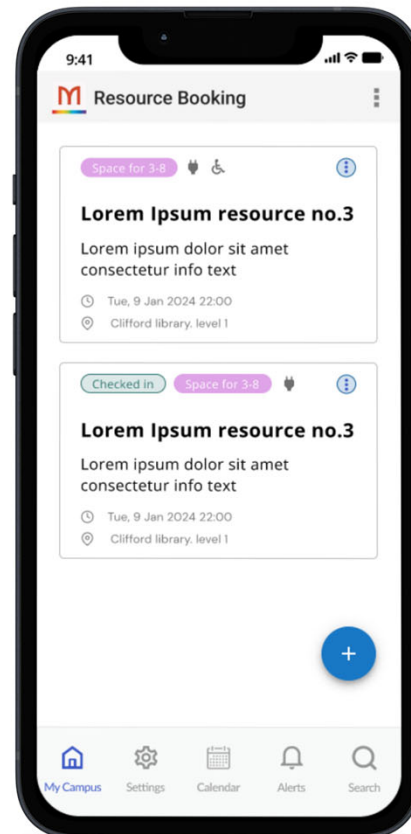

- Check-in and check-out for room bookings



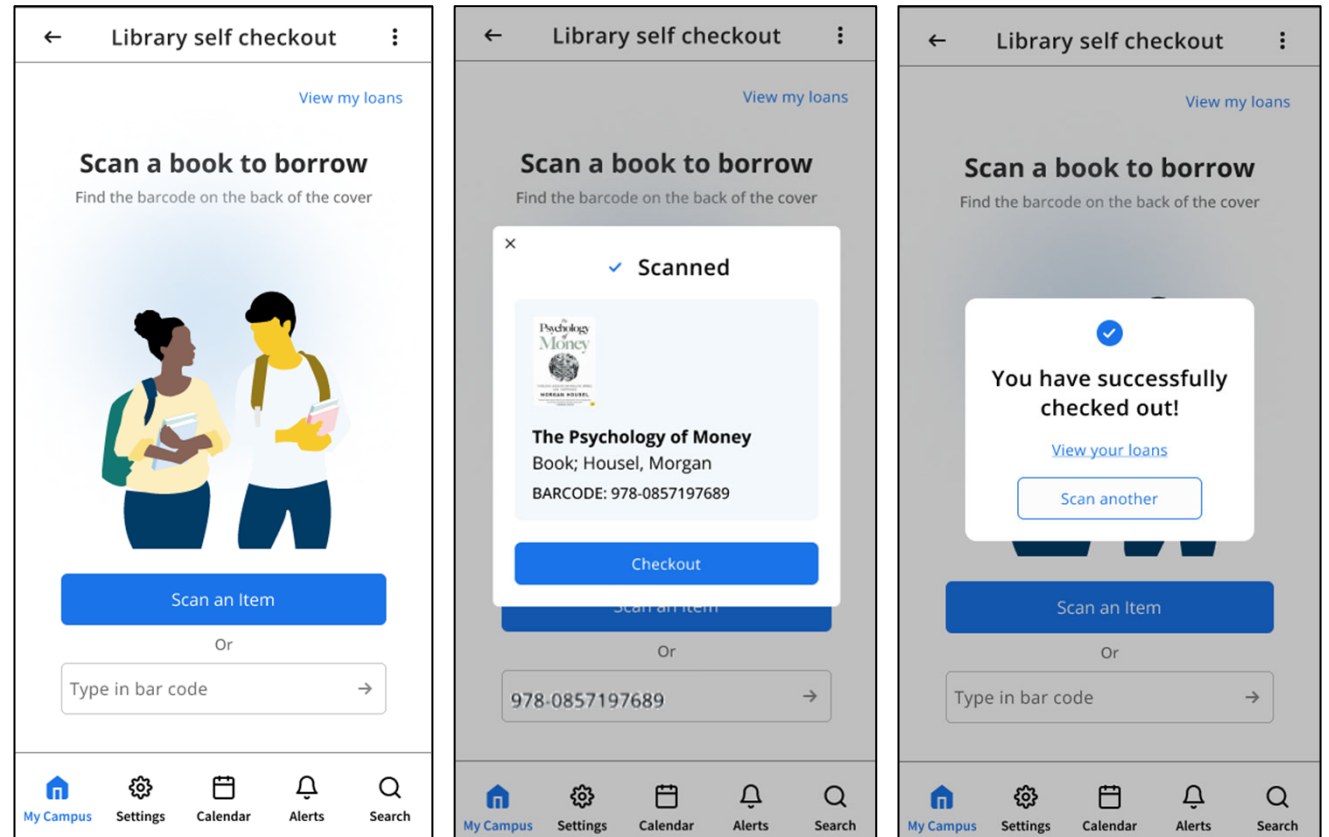

Attendance

- **Ongoing Iterative Improvements**

- Ongoing proactive monitoring of check-in data and customer feedback to improve accuracy and experience.

- **Zoom for attendance camera - July**

- Allow students to zoom with their mobile camera to scan the QR code at the other end of the lecture hall.

- **Enhanced feedback on permission enablement status in API - Q3**

- Provide insight into Location and/or Bluetooth permission status for check-ins performed without the required enablement within the validation outcome in the Check-in Report API

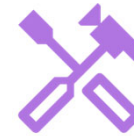

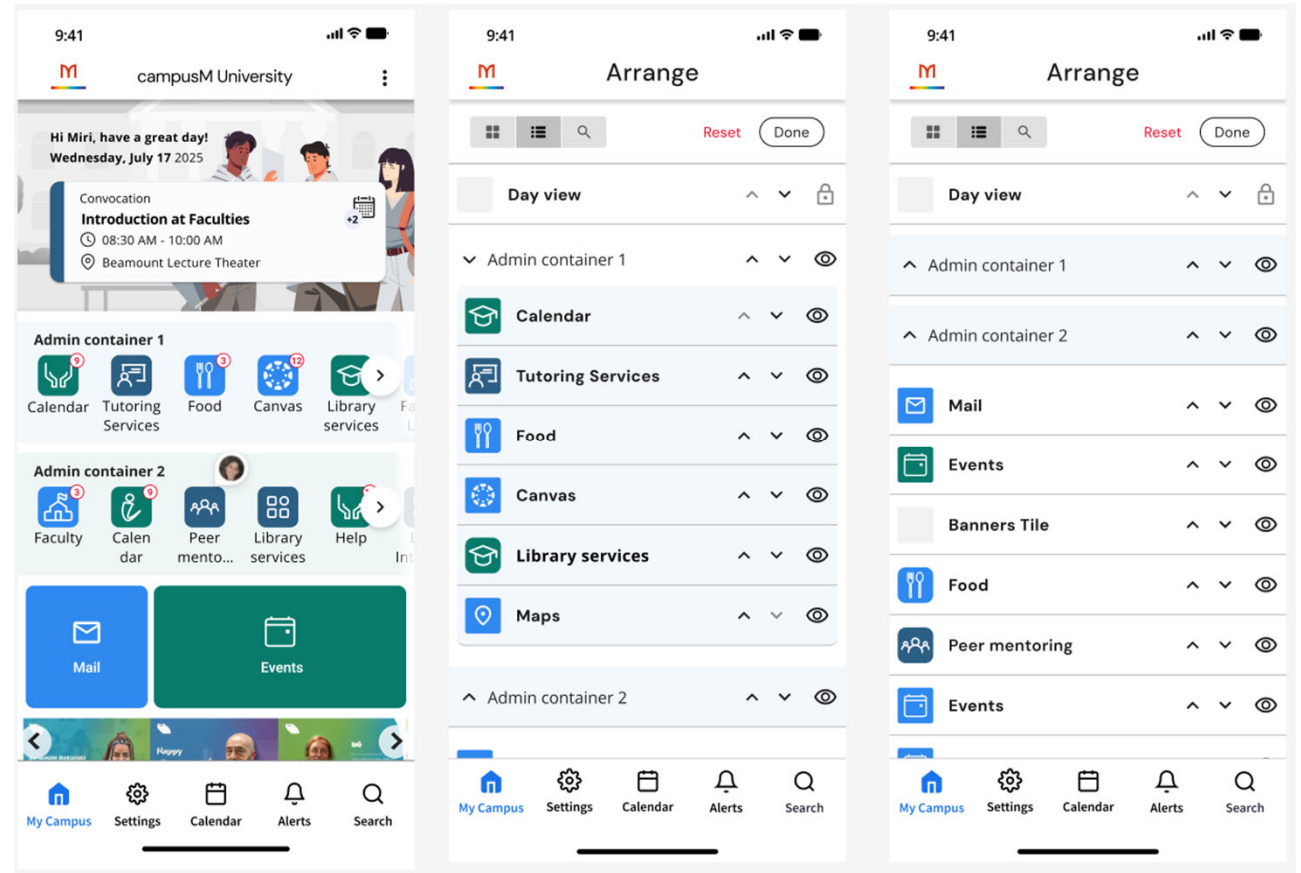
Smart, intuitive and visually appealing app, that will enable the student to gain quick access to the needed information and easily act upon it.

Hyper-personalization - Coming Home

- Phase 1 - Improving Nested Tiles
 - User can arrange within a tile configured by the Admin
 - Ability for Admin to configure size, color, labels to match app branding
 - Notification Badges for sub-tiles
- Phase 2 - Favorites Tile
 - Ability for users to mark tiles as favorites for quick access.
