Add review file exporting for more reports

There are some Decision Center reports that cannot be exported to Sierra's Create Lists. Libraries could make better use of Decision Center bib or item reports if they could be exported to Create Lists.

We have added support for review file exporting to the following reports:

Statistics Group number no longer in Statistics Group by Transaction Type Report Export Only the Statistics Group name, NOT the Statistics Group number, was included as a column, when exporting the Statistics Group by Transaction Type Report. Previously (prior to DC 1.2.12) both the Statistics Group name and Statistics Group number were included in the export. This	DC-9949

<p>Enlarge Images in Popular Titles Report HTML Export</p> <p>Images in the Popular Titles HTML export have been enlarged to 150 x 150 px</p>	DC-9947
<p>Export of Low Circulation Weeding report to PDF or Excel causes Java to crash</p> <p>When customer tries to export low circulation report as either PDF or Excel they see an error in the browser and report is unable to be exported. This has been fixed. This was delivered as hotfix.</p>	DC-9934
<p>DC email/schedule will not accept an email address with a hyphen/dash</p> <p>Emailing a report to an email address with a hyphen in either the left-hand or right-hand side of the email address causes an error message, "There is an invalid character in the Email Addresses field. A comma must be used to separate email addresses" and the report cannot be sent. This has been fixed.</p>	DC-9912
<p>Transactions not moving from click_staging into click_facts and if collection error in erdatasync log</p> <p>Erdatasync was finishing with a FATAL status and the click_facts table was not populated. This has been fixed.</p>	DC-9910
<p>Decision Center Budget Projection by Collection report does not display circulation stats correctly</p> <p>Budget Projection by Collection Report has been fixed to display circulation stats under "selected year's circulations" column correctly based on the filter parameter selections</p>	DC-9908
<p>The Drought Remedy report's Copies in Branch field shows items at sending location and items that are checked out</p> <p>The Drought Remedy report's Copies in Branch field is now showing the Available Copies (i.e. status = '-' and due date is null) at the drought location.</p>	DC-9822

<p>Finnish date format in date filter</p> <p>When the user's browser is set to a European country, for example Finland or Spain, the Decision Center Date filter should display dd/mm/yyyy. This has been fixed.</p>	<p>DC-9734</p>
<p>Nightly process generated partial statistics for a certain date in Decision Center circulation reports</p> <p>The nightly conversation generated partial statistics for a certain date. Data was not moving from the click_staging table to the click_fact table. This has been fixed.</p>	<p>DC-9608</p>
<p>Encore searches not transferring to Decision Center</p> <p>Encore searches were not migrating to Decision Center during the nightly conversation. This issue has been fixed and the records are now being moved to the click_fact table.</p>	<p>DC-9219</p>
