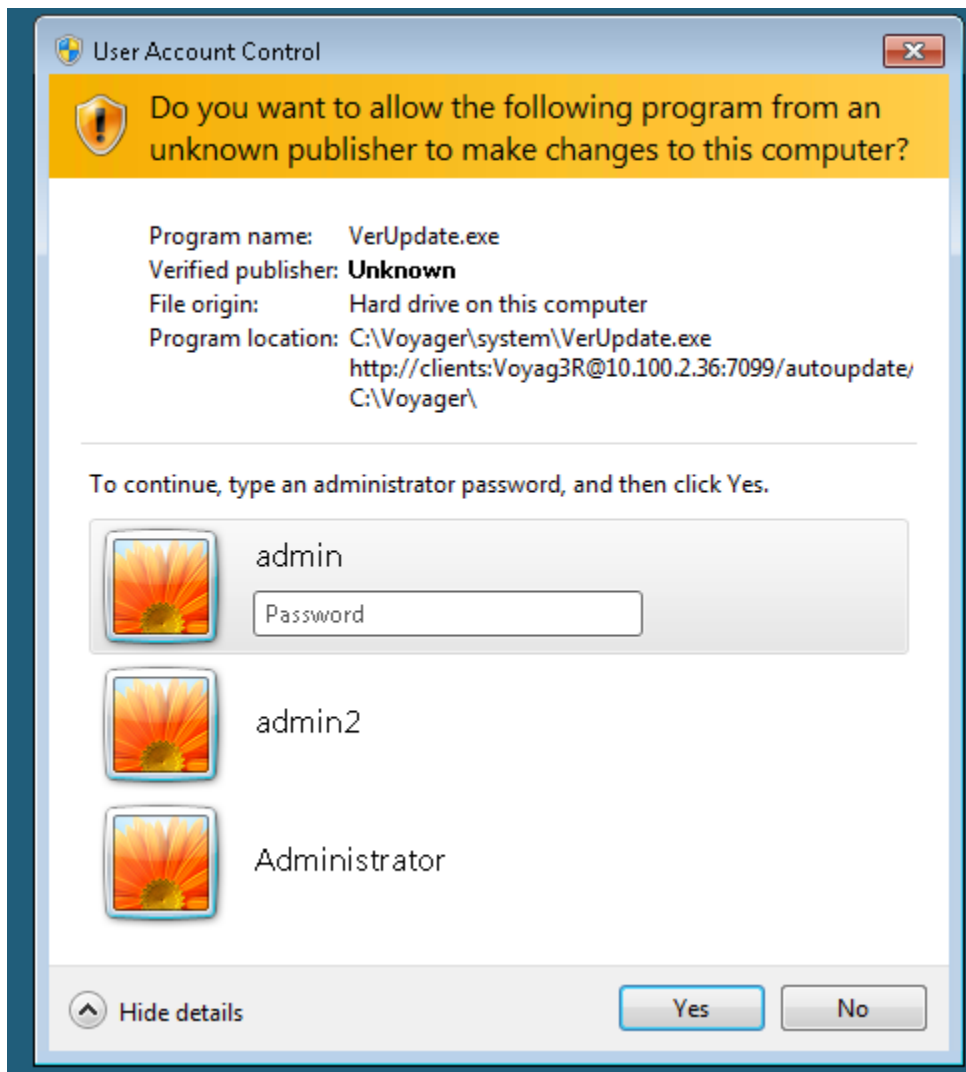


Voyager 8.x Release Note for Client Auto Update

Due to Microsoft's implementation of User Account Control (UAC) in Windows Vista and Windows 7.0, either of the following two solutions must be employed in order to have the Voyager client auto update work after a Voyager server software upgrade:

- 1) An administrative user account/password must be distributed to those staff who will be upgrading their Voyager clients. When the client update process starts, the users will be prompted for an administrator ID and password in order to permit updates to the Voyager client software. Once the user enters the administrator's password and acknowledges by selecting Yes, the client auto update process will run.

- 2) Administrators can whitelist the Voyager VerUpdate.exe program, found in the System folder contained in the folder in which Voyager is installed (generally C:\Voyager), on the workstations. Whitelisting this program permits standard users to update the Voyager client software without administrative credentials. Whitelisting is done using Microsoft's Application Compatibility Toolkit.
