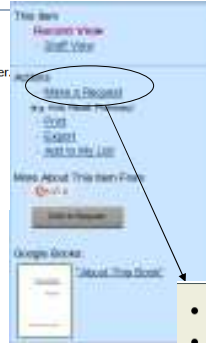

How WebVoyage plays with the rest of Voyager's modules

- Acquisitions – displays serials information; new serials checked in are listed here.
- Cataloging – creates the catalog that patrons search in WebV
- Circulation – completes patron's WebVoyage requests and renewals, displays fines/fees and any circulation blocks
- Reporter – processes hold/recall requests, including those made from WebVoyage
- SysAdmin – settings for OPAC circulation and patron permissions; set up OPAC Circ Desk.
